



DESIGN INTENT

This simple typology is designed to provide a high yield from a site equal to a normal single residence block. The terraces are narrow, 3.8m internally, and tall at 3 storeys, plus basement, plus roof terrace.

Each residence will have direct access to ground level courtyards and all units can be oriented with a northern aspect. This typology, while ubiquitous in most cities, is currently absent in the established suburbs of the Canberra market. It provides an alternative to apartment living and approaches 'house' living. It is simple to construct and has simple domestic structural spans from wall to wall reducing construction costs.
