



2018 Droga Residency Application Terms & Conditions

Eligibility

- Undergraduate students of Architecture are not eligible to apply.
- Architecture applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in the field of application, must have at least seven years of professional experience, and must be practising in the field of architecture.
- Applicants must not reside in Australia.
- Residents may hold other fellowships concurrently, however the requirements of such fellowships must not conflict with the obligations of the residency.
- Applicants are required to disclose all fellowships and awards they expect to hold during their proposed residency.

Collaborative Proposals

- Collaborative proposals from practice partnerships can be considered however one person should be the principal applicant and apply on behalf of the co-applicant.
- Each applicant's contribution to and role within the proposed residency project should be clearly defined.
- If an application is successful, only one airfare and one stipend will be paid or reimbursed.

Travel & Accommodation

- The Institute will provide the successful applicant with accommodation, a return airfare including airport transfers, and one stipend.
- The resident will receive the first stipend payment upon arrival at the residency. The stipend is to be paid into an Australian bank account to be opened by the applicant upon arrival.
- Costs relating to any subsequent flight changes or additional flights will need to be covered by the Applicant.
- Accompanying persons will be expected to cover their own costs including airfare, airport transfers and living expenses.
- The Institute requires each resident and accompanying persons to have suitable travel and health insurance coverage, including hospitalization cover, and major medical, applying for the entire period of travel in Australia. Proof of insurance must be provided before the residency begins.

Residency Program

- During the period of residency the resident(s) will be expected to engage with local architects and the community via mentorships, seminars, and Foundation related events, as outlined in the Letter of Agreement, and agreed to prior to arrival in Australia.
- The Applicant agrees that all formal requests upon their time while in residency, including for seminars and public events, must be directed via the Program Manager.

Media

- The Applicant agrees that the Foundation and the Institute will be able to promote and disseminate material the Applicant, as resident, shares with the community more widely across Australia, and to retain it for archival purposes.
- The Applicant agrees to undertake media Interviews if reasonably requested by the Foundation and Institute.
- The Applicant agrees to be profiled in all media and publications as the Droga Architect in Residence.
