Adelaide City Council Representation Review

There are 50 Institute member practices operating within Adelaide and so it is important that our members are giving consideration to the current review of the Adelaide City Council's consultation on the representational structure of its elected members. This may have significant impact on the future planning approval processes. Since March 2012, the ACC has been conducting a review of its electoral structure including how members are elected and whether or not the council is divided into wards. The purpose of this review is to ensure that the composition of elected members provides the most beneficial structure for representation of our community.

There are currently three recommendations arising from the consultation:

1. The Lord Mayor elected by the electors for the area; and
2. Six (6) Councillors elected as representatives of the area as a whole; and
3. Four (4) Councillors elected as representatives of four wards as defined in the model above.


