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## **Timber systems in mid-rise buildings database**

The 2016 updates to the NCC included changes that created a voluntary deemed to satisfy solution (DtS) for the use of timber in Class 2, 3 and 5 building systems. To document the adoption of the NCC change for the use of timber systems in mid-rise buildings (4+ storeys) we are looking at building a database of projects in the planning or construction stage.
