

## Terms and conditions

1. Your participation in this competition conducted by The Australian Institute of Architects Foundation (ABN: 641 624 986 51) ("the Foundation") will be deemed as acceptance of the below Terms and Conditions.
2. The competition closes at 11:59pm (AEDT) on March 12, 2015. The judging will take place in Sydney NSW and will be undertaken by Edmund Capon and Shaun Carter. The winner will be announced on the Institute website, and notified by telephone and by email using the contact details provided by the entrant.
3. Employees of the Australian Institute of Architects ("the Institute") are not eligible to enter.
4. The competition is open to architects, graduates and students of architecture.
5. The drawing submitted must be an original work and entrants must own all copyright and moral rights in their submitted work. However, the winner and runner-up grant the Foundation the licence to exhibit and use the drawings submitted and to extend this licence to the Institute for use in its communications.
6. Under the licence the Foundation will have the right to exhibit the original copy of the winning drawing, for up to one year, in the Droga apartment.
7. If your entry is selected as a winning entry, validation of your submitted entry may be undertaken by the Foundation.
8. Flights will be provided to a winner who is based outside NSW, from Australian capital cities only. It will be domestic economy fare, exclude insurance, and is to be booked by the Institute's travel agent.
9. The winning entry will be deemed the major prizewinner of the prizes as listed. The prize does not include any ancillary costs associated with winning the prize. These are the responsibility of the winner.
10. Hotel accommodation and dinner booking is each subject to availability if on a date other than 30 March 2015.
11. A credit card imprint or cash deposit will be required from the winner at check-in of the hotel for all incidental charges which are the winner's responsibility.
12. Air fare value is based upon the fare prices quoted by the Institute's travel agent at the time of competition judging. If the flight is not taken on 30 March 2015 and there is no equivalent fare available when the flight is taken any additional flight cost will be the responsibility of the winner.
13. The prize (or any part thereof) cannot be sold, is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken for cash. Applicants must be aged 18 years or over to accept the accommodation prize offered by Blue Hotel.
