

Playing with Rain


Hi P,

This proposal utilises an existing public space and transforms it into an intervention that is activated by water.

During a downpour, the space is transformed.







A downpour is a temporary event.

This proposal provides a space for shelter, a space for conversations, and a space for play.

Water runs down the roof and fills it up internally, dramatically changing the look and the acoustics.





To see the intervention from afar highlights the liquid texture, the physical qualities of rain, as it interacts with the outer shell.
