'The Building Codes Committee (BCC) is the ABCB's peak building technical advisory body. The BCC is a valuable national forum for regulatory authorities and industry to consider technical matters relevant to building regulation reform and plays an active role in assisting the Board in meeting its obligations under the Council of Australian Governments (COAG) Guidelines and the Intergovernmental Agreement.

The BCC operates in alignment with the ABCB's Plumbing Code Committee to ensure a coordinated approach to building and plumbing regulatory reform.'

Expression of interest in becoming the Institute's representative on this committee is sought from members.

The Institute is seeking a representative with demonstrated experience in regulatory matters and their complexity through current practice and for at least 15 years before now, in documenting a wide variety of building projects in Australia.

As the Institute's representative, you may be instructed by the National President or CEO to take a certain position in relation to an issue being considered and to promote that position in decision making.

Representatives must be prepared to commit to attending all meetings except in exceptional personal circumstances. Meetings are usually held over 2 days and approximately 3 times per year, in various capital cities. If you are an employee, a director or partner of your practice must endorse this form with their signature to verify that you will be permitted to attend meetings during working hours. Travel and accommodation is arranged and covered by the Institute, or reimbursable.

In keeping with Institute policy, the initial term will be 2 years, renewable for continuous service with a second 2 year term, and with a third 2 year term only possible at the National President or CEO's discretion.

The selection will be made by the Institute's National Executive Committee on advice of Institute staff, who may seek verification of experience from peers and other members of your practice if they see fit, not necessarily confined to the referee you nominate on this form. By submitting this expression of interest we take it that you have given us permission to make enquiries of this nature.
